



Road Name or Road Name Change

The following are the procedures for obtaining a road name or road name change. You will need to follow these procedures to avoid having a petition rescinded. **Signatures must be of persons owning the property not renters.**

- ▶ A petition must be submitted to our office using our form.
- ▶ There must be at least three (3) residential homes on the road.
- ▶ There should be a designated contact person to sponsor the petition and have it notarized.
- ▶ Provide three (3) choices of road names and specify your 1st, 2nd, and 3rd preference of road name.
- ▶ 100% of the landowners on the road must sign the petition to be valid. Whether they agree or disagree with the road name.
- ▶ 80% of the landowners on the road must agree on the name choices for the petition to be valid.
- ▶ Name, address, home phone numbers must be provided for each person signing the petition.
- ▶ Landowners not residing on the road need to provide the address of the property they own on said road and the address and phone number of their residence.

- **Important** If our office receives a call from an owner who has not signed the petition, even if it has previously been approved, we will revoke the petition for not being valid.

- Should a landowner refuse to sign because they are in disagreement, make a notation on the petition “refusal to sign”. The name, address and phone number of that person should be placed on the petition so the 9-1-1 office may contact them to verify their position.

Return the notarized petition to the 9-1-1 Administration Office. The 9-1-1 Office will check for road name duplications, valid signatures and will call the contact person with any questions we may have on the petition. When this is completed the petition will be forwarded to the County Judge for consideration. The residents will be notified of the approval or disapproval of the County Judge’s decision on the road name by the 9-1-1 Office.
