



MATERIALS ACCEPTED

Household quantities of the following items will be accepted by residents of Benton County.

Commercially-generated products cannot be accepted.

- **Automotive Products** - motor oils, oil filters, brake and transmission fluids, and antifreeze
- **Automotive Batteries** - lead-acid
- **Paints, Thinners, Strippers and Non-Chlorinated Solvents** - oil-, water- and latex-based, stains, shellacs, lacquer, varnish, turpentine and aerosol cans
- **Household Pesticides and Herbicides** - over-the-counter products only
- **Fluorescent and HID Light Bulbs**
- **Dry Cell and Button Batteries** - alkaline, nickel-cadmium
- **Sharps (Rogers facility only)** - used medical needles must be delivered in a heavy, clear plastic container



TRANSPORTING HHW PRODUCTS SAFELY TO THE COLLECTION CENTER

- Bring products in their original container
- If the product container is deteriorating and/or leaking, place the entire container in another container and include the original label if possible or clearly label the new container
- Securely package products so they will not spill during transportation
- Always transport HHW products in your automotive trunk or truck bed - away from passengers - never in the passenger compartment
- Do not eat, smoke, or drink while handling HHW products
- Do not mix the contents of different or unknown containers together
- Keep HHW products away from children and pets
