Dear Mr. Sigel:

Please refer to your letter dated, November 29, 2012, on behalf of the City of Siloam Spring concerning Department of the Army (DA) permit requirements pursuant to Section 404 of the Clean Water Act. You requested authorization to stabilize and enhance the stream bank, create in-stream fish habitat and improve whitewater recreation in the Illinois River. The proposed sit is located in Section 29, T. 17 N., R. 33 N., Siloam Springs, Benton County, Arkansas.

The proposed activity is authorized by Department of the Army Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 27 (copy enclosed), provided that the conditions therein, are met. You should become familiar with the conditions and maintain a copy of the permit at the worksite for ready reference. If changes are proposed in the design or location of the facilities, you should submit revised plans to this office for approval before construction of the change begins.

Please refer to NWP Condition No. 12, which stipulates that appropriate erosion and siltatio controls be used during construction and all exposed soil be permanently stabilized. Erosion control measures must be implemented during and after construction of the proposed project to comply with this permit condition.

In order to fully comply with the conditions of the NWP, you must submit the enclosed compliance certification within 30 days of completion of the project. This is required pursuant General Condition No. 30 of the permit.

The NWP determination will be valid for two years unless the NWP is modified, suspended or revoked within the two-year period. If NWP No. 27 is modified, suspended, or revoked during this period, your project may not be authorized unless you have begun or are under contract to begin the project. If work has started or the work is under contract, you would then have twelve months to complete the work.

The authorization of this work by a NWP does not relieve you of complying with other applicable local, state, and Federal laws. You are reminded that any future proposal for the discharge of dredged or fill material in waters of the United States requires prior approval from the Corps of Engineers under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act.
