

Amendments

* Under existing statute 12-12-906 (2) "K" – "Date and place of any employment" add "volunteer work"

(2) "Q" – Include "password" to existing requirements such as "username" and "screen name"

Under 12-12-923 (2014):

- (a)(1) "Upon release from incarceration, a sex offender determined to be a sexually dangerous person...." Change the wording to "Upon release from incarceration or upon entry into this state from another state, a sex offender assessed as a Level 3 or Level 4..."

Under 12-12-901:

- Include "Shall not be present, attend functions, games or events in places where children congregate, such as any school property, school yards, parks, playgrounds, daycares, church youth groups or programs without written permission from Sex Offender Registration Officer whom they report to."

Add

- Any sex offender, who is required to register, and who has been assessed as a Level 3 or Level 4, cannot **work or volunteer**, within 2,000 feet of any place where children congregate, such as any school property, school yards, parks, playgrounds, daycares, church youth groups or programs.

New Laws

* It shall be unlawful for anyone required to register as a sex offender, to possess a Concealed Carry Handgun license.

* It shall be unlawful for anyone required to register as a sex offender, to possess or produce any pornographic, sexually oriented, or sexually stimulating, visual, auditory, telephonic, or electronic media, including computer programs or services.

* It shall be unlawful for anyone required to register as a sex offender to enter or remain in the vicinity of any establishment that derives its primary source of income through the sale of sexually oriented or sexually stimulating products or services, such as adult book stores, gentleman's clubs, or strip clubs.

* Any sex offender, who is required to register, and who has been assessed as a Level 3 or Level 4, and whose offense was against a minor, shall not stay or reside overnight in a residence where minor children are living or staying.

* It shall be unlawful for anyone required to register as a sex offender to reside with any other person who has also been convicted of a sex related offense.

* Any sex offender, who is required to register, and who has been assessed as a Level 3 or Level 4, cannot have internet access.
