

Request for Parcel(s) Combination

Please note: This parcel(s) combination will be for tax purposes only. It will not change or have any effect on the legal lot or tract boundary lines. If you wish to change the boundary lines you will need to contact the Benton County Planning Department for parcels that begin with a 15- or 18- parcel number; or the applicable Municipal Planning Department that has jurisdiction over the replat process for lots in platted subdivisions or for property line adjustments in your area.

Certain criteria must be met in order to combine parcels. They are:

- The parcels must be owned by the same person or entity.
- The parcels must be adjoining.
- The parcels must be in the same school district.
- The parcels must all be within the same city limits, or all must be outside of the city limits (not a mixture).
- The parcels must be in the same section-township-range or same subdivision (not a mixture).
- Taxes must be current and paid to date on the parcels to be combined.
- We cannot combine parcels for past years.
