FIREWORK INSPECTION CHECKLIST

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- State License Posted
- Certification of Flame Retardant Treatment to Tent
- NO Combustible Materials within 25' of Tent
- 12' Fire Break Around Tent
- Location is 25' from Buildings, Parked Vehicles or Other Tents
- Dumpster is 30' from Firework Storage and Tents
- NO Gas-Powered Equipment within 25' of Tent
- NO Flammable Liquids within 25' of Tent
- Proof of Temporary Electrical Permit
- Provision of Safe and Adequate Parking on Site

FIRE PROTECTION

- TWO (2) 2-A Fire Extinguishers Mounted, Assessible and Inspected
- Water Extinguisher Mounted, Assessible and Inspected

LINE SAFETY

- NO SMOKING Signs Posted
- TWO (2) Exits Both Minimum Openings of 48" Wide
- EXIT Signs Posted
- Aisles and Walkways Clear and a Minimum of 48' Wide
- Pathway of 36" Between Contents and Exterior Wall

ELECTRICAL

- Extension Cords in Good Working Order
- Lighting Cords and Fixtures in Good Working Order

IMPORTANT NOTE

The Benton County Fire Marshal will issue the Temporary Use Permit upon inspection of the facility. NO retail sales shall be conducted on site without the Temporary Use Permit posted on site. The Temporary Use Permit applicant MUST contact the Benton County Fire Marshal to schedule an inspection. Actual issuance of the Temporary Use Permit shall be performed by the Benton County Fire Marshal.

Firework stands and commercial fireworks displays are commercial activities that are temporary and are required to be removed following the expiration of a permit.
